So, whether you're going home for the holidays or staying here in Hull, we want to make sure you and your belongings stay safe.

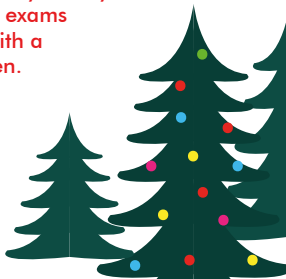
Keep thieves out at Xmas:

FIVE FESTIVE TIPS

4. Check your contents insurance is valid... JUST IN CASE!
5. If you have a burglar alarm TURN IT ON!
